



Bursary Application Guidance:

Please provide as much as possible from the following if applicable as pdfs, copies attached in one email to youngchambermusic999@gmail.com with your name and instrument stated:

- a letter from the team at your school confirming that you receive Pupil Premium or Free School Meals (if you do receive them); or similar for international applicants
- documents to show you (or your family) receive government benefits (if you are not in education, employment or training and can't get a Pupil Premium or Free School Meals record); or similar for international applicants
- a copy of a council tax letter, as proof of address;
- copies of any musical certificates or achievements or a CV, if you want to show us any of these to enhance your application (not essential);
- a link to a YouTube or other online video recorded within the last three months;
- Please provide us with any other financial documents and material you feel would help your application e.g. yearly statement such as P60 End of Year Certificate or a monthly payslip; or similar for international applicants
- a reference or email letter from a musician of standing who is supporting your work (this could be your teacher/ Director of Music/ Head of Conservatoire)
- a personal statement from you explaining why it would be important to participate in our course, what quality and commitment you would bring to it,
- Your personal statement should contain some of the following:
 - —> What your instrument and playing means to you
 - —> What are your aims with chamber music are and what you would like to achieve with your music
 - —> How have you shown dedication and commitment with your music and musical training in the last year
